THE LEGION CAP

The only official part of the American Legion Uniform is the Legion Cap. There are a couple of styles and they come in Men's and Women's. They can be found in the American Legion, Flag, and Emblem Store.

A new initiative for members to purchase a cap is that if you attend 3 meetings within a 6 month period, then Post 9 will reimburse you 50% of the purchase. That could be up to a \$35.00 savings with the submission of your receipt. This does not include District Caps.

Now, if you have been a member of the legion and your cap has become old and not presentable, we will make the same 50% deal with you. Contact the Sgt-At-Arms to see if you qualify for a replacement.

2022 - 2023 POST OFFICER ELECTIONS

The election for the new post officers is just around the corner and it will be upon us quickly. First and foremost if you are planning on running for an officer position or wanting to be an appointed position (Adjutant, Finance Officer) you will also have to have a background check. A background check is required by the Georgia Secretary of State for us to maintain our Bingo License. The post will pay for it. See Sr-Vice Anderson for the background check information. The Office positions that are up for elections are Commander, Sr-Vice Commander, and 4 Jt-Vice Commander Positions. The nominations will be taken at the April, May, June General Meetings, with the election during the June Meeting. The induction will be held in July. These dates are subject to change based on the Department of Georgia Convention.
