Thoughts from the Chaplain Pray for America

Fellow Legionnaires, I found the below "Call to Prayer" online. I thought this couldn't come at a better time with all the local concerns, Legion challenges, and world affairs the state that they are in. Our world is currently in terrible condition.

"As believers, it is our responsibility to pray for America – always, not just in times of national crisis. Without diminishing the importance of the Supreme Court or the Congress or the President, they are not the source of our future or our hope. Only God and the power of the Holy Spirit working in the lives of citizens can sustain the strength and the future of the nation. <u>James 5:16</u> encourages us that "the effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much", and throughout the Bible, we see how true these words are. Prayers moved the hand of God and changes came to nations, leaders, laws, and individuals. S.D. Gordon said, "The greatest thing anyone can do for God and man is, pray. It is not the only thing, but it is the chief thing."

First, as God's people, we must humble ourselves and confess to God the sins of our nation, as well as our own lives – our self-centeredness, lust, addictions, the love of the world, and any area in which we are disobeying His Word. 2, **Chronicles 7:14** "If my people who are called by my name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and forgive their sin and heal their land."


THE LEGION CAP

The only official part of the American Legion Uniform is the Legion Cap. There are a couple of styles that come in Men's and Women's sizes. They can be found in the American Legion, Flag, and Emblem Store.

A new initiative for members to purchase a cap is that if you attend three meetings within six

months, then Post 9 will reimburse you 50% of the purchase. That could be up to a \$35.00 savings with the submission of your receipt. This offer does not include District Caps.

Now, if you have been a member of the legion and your cap has become old and not presentable, we will make the same 50% deal with you. Contact the Sgt-At-Arms to see if you qualify for a replacement.
