In this opening I just want to make sure that everyone is aware of the dangers hurricanes present. When I first moved to Brunswick in 2018 I was oblivious to just how dangerous they can be. So this post is aimed at anyone that is like I was and unaware of these dangers. (You lifelong Brunswick natives can laugh at this young whipper snapper) In addition to the hours to possibly days of intense winds and rain bombarding your house, the storm surge is arguably the most dangerous aspect of a hurricane. I am including a couple of links to help educate you about hurricanes in general, links to storm surge maps, and evacuation groups and routes.

In other news, I have a history question for you. How many events have Post 9 joined forces with another post in Glynn County to pull off? Going way back in time there may have been a few at best, but in recent history only one. All three posts presented awards to the workers of the Golden Ray, July 1, 2023, Post 9 and Post 507 combined forces with a color guard that presented the colors for an awards ceremony honoring Dr. Rosemary Woods who received the Presidential Lifetime Achievement Award. Commander Howard and two of his post members were present along with Sr. Vice Commander Mike WIlliams, and Jr. Vice Commander Karen Williams. Post 507 carried the American Flag, and the Legion Flag, while Post 9 carried rifles. The event went off without a hitch (At least on the combined color guard's part) and it was a beautiful ceremony. In addition to this, ALL 3 POSTS are working together on a Ceremony called "A Day to Remember." This is a very involved event, remembering those First Responders that lost their lives in the 9/11 attacks and the veterans that lost theirs as a result of the Global War on Terrorism. It will be held at the Brunswick Veterans Memorial Park. We are currently still in the planning stage, but as it stands now church bells will ring at the time each plane struck a tower, the Pentagon, and went down in a field in Pennsylvania; The Brunswick Fire Department will be striking the four fives as a tribute to the fallen Firefighters, and Post 9 is hosting a special blood drive on September 11. Please if you are able, attend this event. It will be a special event, and one you will remember.

<u>MEMBERSHIP</u>

We are starting a new year for the American Legion and it's time for dues again. The annual dues are \$35 as they have always been. The most members recruited and the most active participating members winner was the same person Otis "Skip" Putnam. We have 64 members that have already paid for this upcoming year. This puts us at 24% this year, going with last year's numbers. We do not have our new goal for the upcoming year as of yet.
